YOUTH MARKET MEAT GOAT SHOW

1. ELIGIBILITY: Entries are open to youth 19 or under (Based on date of June 13, 2009). Animals entered in the Market Meat Goat Show are not eligible to show in the Breeding Boer Goat Show.
2. This show is open to any breed or crossbred wether or doe.
3. Goats will be weighed by show officials on Saturday, June 13, 2009 from 8:00 – 9:30 a.m. Goats will then be divided into weight classes as equal in number as possible. (Number of Classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show officials' discretion.)
4. All goats must be carrying all milk teeth at time of weighing. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will not be eligible to show.
5. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
6. **Bracing of the goats will not be permitted for this show.**
7. Entry Fee: \$10.00 per entry and \$5.00 per pen, includes first bedding. Additional bedding will be available for sale.
8. A late fee will be charged for late entries for Market Meat Show. All late entries will have an entry fee of \$15.

Judges decision is final in all circumstances. Arguing with the judge or show officials is grounds to be excluded from the show.

Please complete the attached Market Meat Goat Show entry form for each child exhibiting in the show.

SHOWMANSHIP

Exhibitors from both the Market Meat Goat Show and Sanctioned Youth Boer Goat Show are eligible to participate in the Showmanship Class. Animals exhibited in showmanship must also be entered in either the Market Meat Goat weight classes or the Sanctioned Youth Boer Goat Show, or pay a separate registration fee of \$7.

Showmanship classes will be divided into age groups as equal in number as possible. (Number of Classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show officials' discretion. Showmanship is open to all youth under the age of 19 as of the date of the show.

Show officials reserve the right to combine classes in all contests in the show.

T-SHIRTS

T-Shirts are available for purchase by participants and family members. Pre-orders are strongly recommended. There is no guarantee that shirts will be available at the show. Pens are limited to two pens per exhibitor for the entire show and available on a first come, first serve basis. No tack pens will be available.

EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY CONTEST

The purpose of this contest is to help Youth increase their communication skills through the creative display of a message or education of the Boer Goat Industry through an educational display.

Youth are encouraged to established displays to educate others about the Boer Goat breed or the Meat Goat industry in general. The Show Judge or designee will judge the displays.

EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY CONTEST GUIDELINES

1. Contestants must be entered in the Market Meat or Breeding goat show.
2. All work must be that of the entrant.
3. Each entrant must his/her own table for the display. Each table should have an appropriate table cover.
4. All displays, backboard, etc. should be free standing. (Nothing may be attached to walls, ceilings, panels, or other fixed items.
5. Materials on display should promote the Youth's involvement in the Boer Goat or Meat Goat industry.
6. There will be two age divisions: 10 and under; and 11 and over
7. Possible topics include, but are not limited to: Youth Involvement and leadership; Showing / Showmanship Awareness; Educational topics about the breed or goats in general (Example, Health, hoof care, fence building, kidding, etc.)
8. **Entries must be submitted for display by 9:30 a.m. on June 13, 2009. Late entries will NOT be judged.**
9. Premiums for winning entries of the display contest will be awarded for each age group.

3. Each scrapbook should be a self contained, bound book; include a title page, table of contents, introduction that explains your goat project, and page numbers. All contents should be securely fastened with no loose objects.
4. **Entries must be submitted for display by 9:30 a.m. on June 13, 2009. Late entries will NOT be judged.**
5. Premiums for winning entries of the scrapbook contest will be awarded for each age group.

SHOW RULES

The IBGA sanctions this show and its rules shall govern. All registered animals welcomed, regardless of registering organization. Points will be awarded based on the IBGA points system and animals must be registered IBGA to obtain points.

- Base date for computing animal's age is June 13, 2009
- A registered certificate is required for all animals. Tattoos must be legible and match the registration paper.
- Goats must be registered in child's name or family ranch membership. Proof of family membership will be required.
- All goats must have a current health certificate. It is the owner's responsibility to conform to all interstate transport laws. In compliance with current USDA animal movement restrictions.
- Registration certificate and current health papers must be presented to show secretary prior to show.
- Animals must be in place by 10:00 A.M. Saturday, June 13, 2009. Animals must vacate the barn at end of show.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED! Animals not being shown are prohibited unless a kid is nursing, then the kid and doe must have current health papers.
- Georgia State Veterinary will inspect all animals and will bar from the grounds any animal that is obviously sick, diseased or parasite infected.
- The show committee reserves the right to set reasonable standards for conduct by the exhibitors.

***The promoters and members of the show committee will not be responsible for animals, personal property, accidents, and/or injury.**
